Selection of Folk Troupes

Proposals by registered post are invited by Project Director, J&K State AIDS Prevention and Control Society for hiring of folk troupes for dissemination of information on HIV/AIDS from **folk groups** registered or empanelled with Song & Drama Division, Government of India or the Department of Culture, Government of J&K having expertise in a particular folk form of the State for the year 2014-15.

The main aim of this activity will be to disseminate information on HIV/AIDS through cultural/folk performances especially among the rural populations residing in different parts of the State in the various folk forms/styles of the region.

Each performance shall comprise of either song or dance or skit or drama or natak or composite form followed by a lecture and interaction by a trained person on the subject. The selected troupes shall be paid **Rs. 4000/- (Rupees Four Thousand Only)** for each performance subject to its proper authentication, monitoring and evaluation by the concerned officials.
