2. Include HIV/AIDS Topic in the induction and training programmes of employees under Department of Higher Education.
3. Issue instructions to Universities and B.Ed. Colleges for including HIV prevention topic in B.Ed. Courses.
4. Issue instructions to Colleges and Universities for “Best Donor Award” to students for Voluntary Blood Donation during Annual Functions.

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5. Issue instructions to all institutions for discouraging any incidence of social stigma and discrimination to students affected or infected with HIV in the Institutions.

6. Issue instructions to all Educational Institutions to observe below mentioned days including Secondary/Hr. Secondary's as a regular feature in their plan of activities and send report to JKSACS timely:
